### **Geum x 'Banana Daiquiri' PPAF and Geum x 'Cosmopolitan' PPAF**

Intrinsic Perennial Gardens, Inc. is excited to announce the fifth and sixth introduction in our cocktail series of Geum, **Geum x 'Banana Daiquiri' PPAF and Geum x 'Cosmopolitan' PPAF** along with 'Alabama Slammer' PPAF, 'Mai Tai' PP#22,433, 'Sangria', and Tequila Sunrise' PP#21,514, make up this refreshing and tasty group. 'Banana Daiquiri' is a fresh lemony yellow color held on fuzzy green stems while 'Cosmopolitan' has a unique color combination of creamy white drenched in rose pink edges on single and semi double flowers all on burgundy red stems. These new Geums start blooming in late April or May and continue around three to four weeks or more. The short clumping plants reach around 10" tall and wide with the stems reaching 18+" tall. The plants prefer a moist to well drained soil in full sun. The foliage is semi-evergreen. These hybrid plants are longer lived than the older chiloense varieties of Geum. Their hardiness is zone 4-9. These plants do their growing at the cool times of the season, so they can be planted in early spring or early fall. They both combine nice with other Geum and early bloomers like Polemonium 'Heaven Scent' PP#20,214.
