Intrinsic Perennial Gardens, Inc. is excited to announce the thirteenth, fourteenth, fifteenth and sixteenth introductions in our cocktail of Garden gems, Geum x 'Champagne', 'Citronge' PPAF 'Coppertone Punch' PPAF and Geum x 'Peach Daiquiri' PPAF along with 'Alabama Slammer' PP#23,750, 'Banana Daiquiri' PP#25,351, 'Cosmopolitan' PP#24,982, 'Dark and Stormy' PPAF 'Gimlet' PP#26,223, 'Limoncello', 'Mai Tai' PP#22,433, 'Sangria', 'Sea Breeze' PP#26,437, 'Spanish Fly' PPAF and Tequila Sunrise' PP#21,514, 'Wet Kiss' PPAF make up this refreshing and tasty group.

'Champagne' is an extra robust grower with larger hairy foliage and creamy white to near white 1" plus flowers on 18-24" chartreuse green stems. The effect is bubbly and this color works with most any other plant. 'Citronge' has a unique single creamy orange flowers with overlapping petals held on red stems. 'Coppertone Punch' is a semi-double orange with shorter petals on top of full size petals giving the flower a layered look. 'Peach Daiquiri' is another one that blends nicely with most any other color. The single peachy yellow flowers also have red stems and red buds. These new Geums start blooming in late April or May just in time for Mother's Day and continue around three to four weeks or more. The short clumping plants reach around 10" tall and over 12" wide with the stems reaching 15-18+" tall. The plants prefer a moist to well drained soil in full sun. The foliage is semi-evergreen. These hybrid plants are longer lived than the older chiloense varieties of Geum. Their hardiness is zone 4-8. These plants do their growing at the cool times of the season, so they can be planted in late winter, early spring or late summer to early fall. They both combine nice with other Geum and early bloomers like Polomonium 'Heaven Scent' PP#20,214.
