Monarda 'Bumble Bee King' PPAF

A hybrid seedling of 'Midnight Oil', 'Bumble Bee King' has the same habit with a little more height. Both monardas are compact, only half the height of 'Jacob Cline'. A key feature is their genetics to clump rather than spread. After about three years, the plant will be a stand measuring about 30 inches in width. This makes both 'Bumble Bee King' and 'Midnight Oil' ideal plants for home gardens.

'Bumble Bee King' has the same dark leaves as 'Midnight Oil'. A crucial difference is the attractive lavender-pink blooms that top the plant in June, earlier than most purple shaded monardas on the market.

Another important feature is the strong resistance to powdery mildew. If given good air circulation, 'Bumble Bee King' sails through the summer without trouble. This makes the attractive bronze leaves an additional

retail sell—a stand of foliage is an appealing sight in the garden. Leaves have a slightly minty, herbal fragrance to them.

Although 'Bumble Bee King' has a *bradburiana* habit and presentation, both parents are native to North America.

Intrinsic Introductions continues to expand the palette of naturalistic garden designers who champion grasses and perennials to create artistic landscapes that blend with local ecosystems and evolve with the season. By focusing on texture and form in flowing drifts, along with color, naturalistic designers build resilient, low-maintenance gardens that support local wildlife and blend seamlessly with local environments. These living pieces of art are actually functional ecosystems.

We strive to do our part to contribute to that movement. Much of our breeding is focused on the ornamental value of native plants in gardens, both public and private. Pollinator plants in particular seem to be on everyone's lips, and native plants fill this demand best. What better way to attract bees than to grow bee balm? It's a North American native herb widely found across the continent.

MONARDA 'BUMBLE BEE KING'

Probably our best monarda to date, this bee balm has the same small stature, clumping habit, and bronze foliage that make 'Midnight Oil' so interesting. 'Bumble Bee King' adds to the strong ornamental value with its two-toned crowns of lavender and purple.

ALLIUM 'BLUE MOON'

Late season flowers of this hybrid allium verge on sought-after blue. They're perfectly timed to fill the color gap leading into fall. A Garden Choice exclusive.

POLEMONIUM 'PRINCE'

A classic *reptans* variety in three acts: emerging foliage is deep wine purple, followed by iridescent blue flowers that ultimately develop into purple seedheads. In a dramatic twist, the seedheads rival the flowers for beauty. This is a Must Have Perennials exclusive.

SPOROBOLUS 'GOLDEN NEEDLES'

We were pleased to have *Sporobolus 'Golden Needles'* featured on the cover of the new perennial digest launched at AmericanHort's Cultivate show in Ohio.

S. 'Golden Needles' is part of a standout combination in our display/trial garden, interplanted with *Solidago x 'Sugar Kisses'*. The form, texture, and color contrast echoes throughout the season and reads fresh and modern. Our trial garden was expanded to include future introductions for 2027 and beyond.

TRIAL RESULTS

In other trial gardens, we are hearing good things about *Pycnanthemum 'Smoky Mountain Mint'* from a number of sites including Mount Cuba, Penn State, and University of Georgia.

PERENNIAL PLANT ASSOCIATION

For the second time an Intrinsic Introduction has been named PPA Plant of the Year. *A. 'Blackhawks'* received the recognition for 2026 and *Rudbeckia 'American Gold Rush'* in 2023.



The most popular flowering succulents, sedums range from groundcovers to large border perennials. They find themselves in green roof and vertical garden design because of their visual interest and drought tolerance.

Drawing from experience, Horvath profiles 150 of the best varieties with information on zones, plant size, soil and light needs, origin, and landscape use.

Sedums change dramatically with the seasons. In fall they are rich and earthy while in summer they flower in vibrant shades of pink and yellow.

This ornamental blue grama grass can light up the landscape with its prolific, warm earthy-honey-yellow flower heads that gracefully dance above the foliage and catch the early morning and late afternoon sun. Great clump forming grass grows about 24" tall and makes a statement as a mass planting. This grass is tidy, compact, and drought tolerant. Also provides great winter interest opportunities in the landscape. A great alternative to 'Blonde Ambition' for cold hardiness and soils that might retain a bit more winter moisture.

UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE AT KNOXVILLE 2025 Best & Beautiful Report

Midway through the three-year trial, *Aster 'Thunderdome'* is reportedly the favorite aster in the garden for its compact size, good uniformity, and excellent flower coverage.

Geranium 'Huggy Bear' has beautiful large, dark palmate foliage. Mounding plants are a great size with reliable uniformity and striking lavender flowers that contrast nicely. Good winter hardiness.

We met with Mary H. Meyer, PhD in August to review the performance of Intrinsic grass introductions at the arboretum. *Sporobolus 'Golden Needles'* is growing well, holding its golden yellow color for a long time.

MOUNT CUBA

They're busy with a new trial of big and little bluestems including the Intrinsic Introductions *andropogon/schizachyrium* varieties. *Andropogon 'Blackhawks'* has caught the eye of many visitors and gardeners with its strong upright habit. Dark red and purple-toned foliage provides an additional layer of interest.

Pycnanthemum 'Smoky Mountain Mint' is reported as having a great mounding habit and oversized flower heads that the garden staff—and pollinators—love. Iridescent deep purple foliage is a welcome bonus.

MSU is new to trialing Intrinsic's ornamental grasses with pleasing results. **Panicum 'Prairie Dog'** was graded 5.0 (on a scale of 1.0 to 5.0) for very tight upright growth and good color. It was also one of the Featured Five—the top five favorites from this year's trials as chosen by MSU Extension. **Pennisetum 'Water to Wine'** received the highest grade at 5.0.

Extra wide gray-green foliage stands out early in the season on this robustly growing *allium*. In July silvered pink buds open to soft pink, two and a half-inch flower balls. Similar in color to 'Summer Beauty' this plant grows a bit taller to around 24 inches. Full sun, most any soil but wet.

Allium x 'Blue Moon' has rich lavender-purple flowers late in the season that verge on blue at times. Flowers are fully two-inch balls on slightly arching 18-inch stems above gray-green foliage. Plants bloom at just the right time to fill in the late summer gap leading to fall.

They prefer full sun and well drained soil.


